Subject: Request for Proposal 2021-15 Design Service for Transit Bus Station Upgrades

Recommendation

That City Council approves the award of a contract to Planmac Engineering Inc. in the amount of \$145,510.00 (plus HST) for the provision of design services related to the transit bus station upgrades.

Background

The City of North Bay requested proposals from qualified and experienced architecture and engineering consultants for professional services for projects primarily related to the Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program (ICIP) Transit Stream. The projects require architecture and engineering services for design, contract administration and construction assistance for washroom improvements and modifications; terminal upgrades; HVAC systems with controls; landscaping; and shelter restoration and refurbishment. The focus will be to optimize the interior as well as the exterior of the facility to improve overall safety, security and passenger comfort as well as enhancing the pedestrian and age-friendly environment to increase the use of local transit services. The contract includes services related to ongoing upgrades and repairs to the terminal as well as those services required to complete projects related to Transit Terminal Improvements and Transit Terminal Rehabilitation that were approved for funding through the Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program, ICIP - Transit Stream which will cover approximately 73.33 % of eligible costs.

Financial/Legal Implications

A formal bid request, which closed March 18, 2021, was administered by the Purchasing Department and was publically advertised in accordance with the City's Purchasing By-Law 2013-200. Three proposals were evaluated by the Purchasing Manager, Manager Transit, Facilities Coordinator and Special Projects Manager. The evaluation considered experience, qualifications, response to the scope of work and price.

The results are as follows:

The proposal from Planmac Engineering Inc. scored highest and provides the best overall value to the City. Their bid is considered fair and reasonable.

Specific Objectives

Maintain infrastructure across the city in a good state of repair.

Consider all aspects of decisions to fund new infrastructure.

Utilize resources and partnerships to beautify and enhance the appearance of the City.

Maximize funding opportunities with other governments.

Options Analysis

- 1. That City Council approves the award of a contract to Planmac Engineering Inc. in the amount of \$145,510.00 (plus HST) for the provision of design services related to the transit bus station upgrades.
- 2. Do not award a contract. This option is not recommended. HVAC units, outdoor

pathways, pads and shelters require replacement and/or significant maintenance that will result in additional future costs if not addressed. Not addressing the washroom design that improves the overall safety, security and comfort of passengers means repairing and rehabilitating the current facility at 100% municipal costs in the near future to address maintenance issues and functional deficiencies that have been identified.

Recommended Option

That City Council approves the award of a contract to Planmac Engineering Inc. in the amount of \$145,510.00 (plus HST) for the provision of design services related to the transit bus station upgrades.
