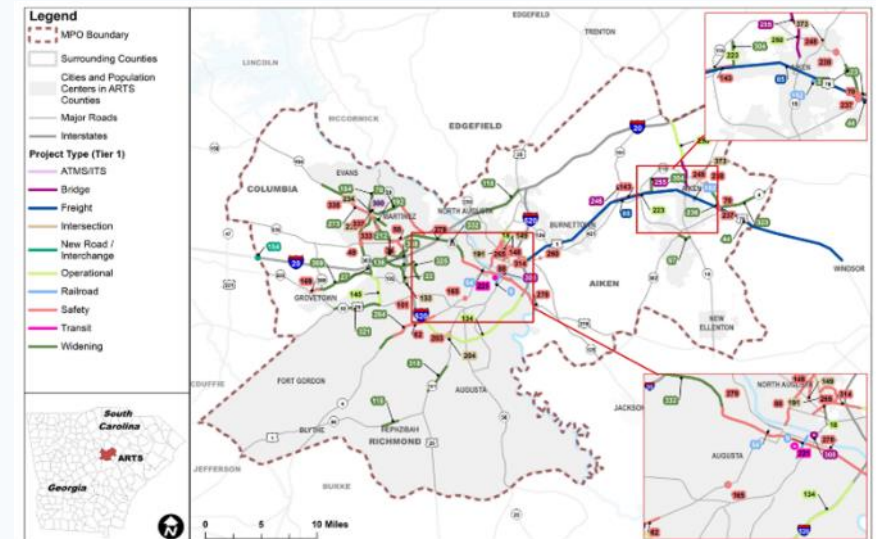
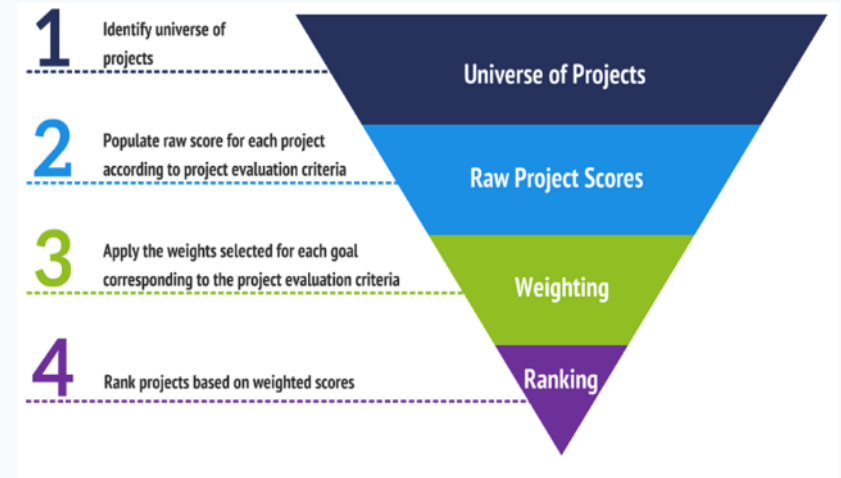
# Key Transportation Factors

- » Multimodal – Vehicles, Bike, Walk & Transit
