









## **Tuesday Weather Map**



- ✓ Wave of energy traverses the Deep South and Southeast United States.
- A line or cluster of showers and thunderstorms, some strong and/or severe, possible across the local area.
- ✓ Severe Thunderstorm or Tornado Watches could eventually be needed Tuesday afternoon/evening










## Severe Weather Outlook: Tuesday

  - ✓ Greatest Impacts Expected Across Inland locations.










# **Tuesday Rainfall Forecast**



✓ Rainfall totals between 1.0-1.5 inches with isolated higher amounts during thunderstorms could produce localized flooding of low-lying and poor drainage areas.












## Wednesday Weather Map



- Warm and unsettled conditions remain across Southeast United States ahead of a cold front.
- ✓ Showers and thunderstorms could be strong and/or severe across the local area during evening and overnight hours when the cold front is near the local area.












## Wednesday Rainfall Forecast




Rainfall totals between 0.5-1.0 during showers and thunderstorms could produce localized flooding of low-lying and poor drainage areas, especially if heavier rains experienced on Tuesday.

- Isolated higher amounts possible.













#### Savannah River





✓ Burtons Ferry and Clyo remain in minor flood today, should be slow to recede with widespread rain anticipated across the region Tuesday through late Wednesday.














## **Max Wind Gust**









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- Breezy winds expected Tuesday (20-25 mph), including coastal waters.
- Small Craft Advisories possible Tuesday into Thursday.







## **Max Wave Height**














Small Craft Advisories possible Tuesday through early Thursday due to 6 ft seas across a portion of coastal waters.
















Once cold front pushes through early Thursday, weather conditions are cooler, but quiet through early next week.



## **Summary / Expected Impacts**

- Severe Thunderstorms
  - Tuesday: Damaging winds, a few tornadoes, and minor flooding possible during afternoon and evening hours.
  - Wednesday: Damaging winds possible during evening and overnight hours.
- River Flooding
  - Burton's Ferry and Clyo along the Savannah River remain in minor flood, could be slow to recede due to expected rain during the week.
- Quiet Weather Thursday through Monday









## **Marine Highlights**

 Small Craft Advisories possible across a portion of Georgia and South Carolina waters Tuesday into Thursday.

## **Aviation Highlights**

 Periods of flight restrictions expected Tuesday through Wednesday night, especially during showers and thunderstorms. Breezy winds also likely Tuesday (20-25 mph) at all terminals.

## **Fire Weather Highlights**

 Near critical RH values today, but conditions will improve through the week, especially as showers and thunderstorms produce widespread rain across the Southeast United States Tuesday and Wednesday.
