12	Section 1	
13	Findings:	
14	The Council finds:	
15	A. There is a critical need for the additional resources to increase the level of service for	
16	public safety in the City of Longmont, including, but not limited to:	
17	1. police officers and personnel for traffic enforcement and to investigate sex	
18	assaults;	
19	2. police officers to ensure safety of officers and to improve emergency response;	
20	3. emergency dispatchers for 911 response;	
21	4. firefighters to ensure safe and sufficient response to emergencies;	
22	5. personnel to support emergency public safety responders; and	
23	6. police and fire equipment and facilities to ensure safety.	

1 B. The City of Longmont City Council desires to refer the question of approval of such 2 taxes to the registered electors of the City of Longmont. 3 Section 2 4 In this ordinance, ellipses indicate material not reproduced as the Council intends to leave 5 that material in effect as it now reads. 6 Section 3 7 The Council amends section 4.04.130 of the Longmont Municipal Code, by adding 8 italicized material and deleting stricken material, to read as follows: 9 4.04.130. - Sales tax levied—Allocation of increased tax for open space acquisition 10 and maintenance and street system maintenance and improvements from special public improvement funds—Sunset clause. 11 12 There is imposed upon all sales of commodities and services specified in Α. 13 section 4.04.080, tax at the rate of 3.53275 percent of the sales price to be computed 14 in accordance with schedules or systems approved by the finance director. Said 15 schedules or systems shall be designed so that no such tax is charged on any sale of \$0.16 or less. 16 17 18 N. All revenues derived from the two and fifty-five one-hundredths of one cent increase approved according to Ordinance O-2017-XX shall be used exclusively to 19 20 provide additional resources to increase the level of service for public safety in 21 Longmont, including, but not limited to: police officers and personnel for traffic

enforcement and to investigate sex assaults; police officers to ensure safety of

officers and to improve emergency response; emergency dispatchers for 911

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response; firefighters to ensure safe and sufficient response to emergencies; personnel to support emergency public safety responders; and police and fire equipment and facilities to ensure safety. The scope of the permissible use of such revenues shall be coterminous with the scope described in subsection (M), above. Accordingly, all such revenues shall also be allocated to the public safety sales tax fund and shall be subject to the same restrictions as other moneys deposited therein. (Approved by voters November 7, 2017.)

Section 4

- The Council amends section 4.04.280 of the Longmont Municipal Code, by adding italicized material and deleting stricken material, to read as follows:
 - 4.04.280. Storage, consumption and use tax levied—Allocation of increased tax for open space acquisition and maintenance and street system maintenance and improvements from special public improvement funds—Sunset clause.
 - A. Except as provided separately in subsections F through K of this section for construction equipment, there shall be levied and there shall be collected from every person a tax or excise for the privilege of storing, using, distributing or otherwise consuming any article of tangible personal property purchased at retail from sources outside the corporate limits of the city, subsequent to the effective date of the ordinance codified in this chapter. Such tax shall be payable to and shall be collected by the director of finance at the rate of 3.53275 percent of the price to be computed in accordance with schedules or systems approved by the finance director. Said schedules or systems shall be designed so that no such tax is charged on any sale of \$0.16 or less.

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P. All revenues derived from the two and fifty-five one-hundredths of one cent increase approved according to Ordinance O-2017-XX shall be used exclusively to provide additional resources to increase the level of service for public safety in Longmont, including, but not limited to: police officers and personnel for traffic enforcement and to investigate sex assaults; police officers to ensure safety of officers and to improve emergency response; emergency dispatchers for 911 response; firefighters to ensure safe and sufficient response to emergencies; personnel to support emergency public safety responders; and police and fire equipment and facilities to ensure safety. The scope of the permissible use of such revenues shall be coterminous with the scope described in subsection (O), above. Accordingly, all such revenues shall also be allocated to the public safety sales tax fund and shall be subject to the same restrictions as other moneys deposited therein. (Approved by voters November 7, 2017.)

Section 5

Election and Effective Date:

Under section 9.15 of the Longmont Municipal Charter and Article X, Section 20 of the Colorado Constitution, the Council refers this ordinance to the qualified electors of the City for approval at the regular City election now scheduled for November 7, 2017. If approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon, it shall become effective when the City Clerk or other designated election official duly files the required certificate of election.
