


Seismic Survey Area





Seismic Survey Information


- Approximate

- Influences the orientation of horizontal drilling

 Previously most wells were either vertical or directional





MASTER CONTRACT


- Establishes a comprehensive vision for oil and gas development on City properties located in eastern Longmont
- Achieves a number of policy goals
- Complex business deal involving property purchases, consolidated drill site locations, leases, and reciprocal compensation





Consolidated Drill Locations achieved from the Master Contract

Accomplished a reduced surface disruption of a total of 11 drill locations and 2 tank battery locations





Update on Status of State and Local Permitting


- Cub Creek has submitted Limited Use applications to City of Longmont for Koester, Pietrzak and Hernor locations
- City applications in process of review
- Cub Creek has submitted applications to State for same wells
- State approval given to Lower Adrian and Koester. Pietrzak and Hernor in review






Drilling Applications at COGCC

Pipeline Routing Issues


- Pipelines were anticipated in the Master Contract
- Desired to have pipelines extended to consolidated sites to convey oil, gas and produced water
- Routing issues with placement on City property versus County Road right-of-way or other private property





Pipeline Routing Discussions


 Map for possible WCR 5 & 26 pipeline alignment

- Previously achieved P&A of Rider Well
- Achieved commitment to P&A Longmont 8-10 this year – likely this year
