NarrativeINITIAL INFORMATION :

On March 9, 2019 at 0924 hours, I, OFC Holladay heard dispatch air a traffic accident in the area of Main St and 3rd Ave, City of Longmont, County of Boulder, and State of Colorado. Dispatch advised a bicyclist was struck by a black Jeep.

INVESTIGATION :

I arrived on scene and met with a male on the ground. There was blood next to him and he was bleeding from the right side of his forehead. He was complaining of head pain and pain in his legs. I advised medical of his injuries. The male later identified himself as ARR-Edward Kneipher (Edward). Edward was on the bicycle and was struck by a Jeep (CR 19-2141). I had dispatch clear Edward through CCIC/NCIC. He was found to have a valid misdemeanor FTA warrant out of the Boulder County Sheriff's Office for larceny with \$100 bond, DKT #C0872018M000871.

WIT 1 OFC Amber Gembarowski-(Amber) told me as paramedics was treating Edward they removed his boots. They then removed his sock on his left foot. When they did so a bag with suspected methamphetamine fell out. The paramedics then contacted me. I collected the bag and it was later tested and was a presumptive positive for methamphetamine by a NIK kit. The weight of the baggie with the substance was 3.02gg.

Edward was transported to Longs Peak Hospital to be evaluated after being struck by a vehicle. When I arrived WIT 2 Tyler Higgins-(Tyler), who is security with Longs Peak Hospital staff, informed me they found two syringes in Edward's belongings. One syringe was empty and the other had a brown liquid in it. Again it was believed to be methamphetamine. The substance was later tested and was a presumptive positive for methamphetamine by a NIK kit. The weight of the liquid in the syringe was .4gg.

Edward was medically cleared at Long's Peak Hospital and then taken into custody. He was then booked at Longmont Police Department. He was then transported to Boulder County Jail.

During this investigation my body worn camera was on. It was muted at times when speaking with fellow officers. It was also turned off then I was traveling to different locations and back on.

Narrative

INITIAL INFORMATION :

On 03/09/2019 at approximately 0923 hours, Officer Bartlett and I, Officer McCarthy, were dispatched to 3rd Avenue and Main Street on a report of an auto-pedestrian crash that just occurred. This location is in the City of Longmont, County of Boulder, State of Colorado. Longmont Communications Center (Dispatch) advised there was a bicyclist that was hit by a vehicle near the Speakeasy Bar, off of 3rd Avenue and Main Street.

INVESTIGATION :

Upon arrival, Officer Holladay was speaking to the bicyclist. After investigating the crash, I went to Longs Peak Hospital where the bicyclist, Arrestee Edward Kneipher (Edward) (DOB: 10/29/1968) was transported to.

I received a bag with a brown and white granulated substance in it from Officer Holladay. I was advised the bag was found in Edward's sock. I took the bag back to the Longmont Police Department to test the substance. The substance presumptively tested positive for methamphetamine. The substance weighed 3.02 gross grams (witnessed by Officer Bartlett).

I later witnessed Officer Holladay weigh a syringe with a brown liquid solution in it.
