2 A RESOLUTION OF THE LONGMONT CITY COUNCIL APPROVING THE CITY OF  
3 LONGMONT, SERVICES CONTRACT, PROPOSAL # RFP-VS-19065, FOR PUBLIC,  
4 EDUCATIONAL, AND GOVERNMENTAL (PEG) ACCESS TELEVISION SERVICES  
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6 WHEREAS public access television services contracts with the Longmont Cable Trust or  
7 any successor to that entity for providing public, educational, and governmental cable television  
8 services to the residents of the city are to be approved by City Council and are not subject to the  
9 procurement requirements of the Longmont Municipal Code (LMC) listed in section 4.12; and

10 WHEREAS the requirement for approval and exemption from the required competitive  
11 purchasing process outlined in section 4.12 of the LMC does not preclude the City from opening  
12 such services to full, open competition when direction is given by City Council to do so in the  
13 public interest; and

14 WHEREAS under a motion of the City Council at the September 25, 2018 Regular  
15 Meeting, the City of Longmont solicited proposals via a publicly advertised Request for Proposal  
16 (RFP) for providing public communication services to include managing the Public, Educational  
17 and Government Access channels; and

18 WHEREAS the selection process was conducted in accordance with the LMC section  
19 4.12.120, and followed the policies and procedures as outlined in the RFP. A team of five  
20 scoring evaluators and one non-scoring evaluator reviewed and scored each proposal; and

21 WHEREAS the Longmont Observer scored the highest total score by including good use  
22 of new technology, a good approach to the Board and Commission recordings and voice-  
23 searchable archiving, an innovative approach to providing local programming and using many

community groups to help with the creation of programming, and by taking a sustainable funding approach; and

WHEREAS the City and the Longmont Observer wish to enter into a services contract for providing public, educational, and governmental cable television services.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONGMONT, COLORADO, RESOLVES:

Section 1

Pursuant to section 4.12.020(1) of the Longmont Municipal Code, the Council approves and authorizes the Mayor to sign the Services Contract for Public, Education, and Governmental (PEG) Access Television Services referenced in the title of this resolution in substantially the form now before the Council.

Section 2

The Council repeals all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this resolution, but only to the extent of such inconsistency.
