Three types of expenses are included in this appropriation:

- 1. * Represents expenses that have an offsetting new (unbudgeted) revenue source such as grants, donations or fees.
- 2. ** Represents new, previously unbudgeted expenses which require the use of fund balance.
- 3. # Represents new, previously unbudgeted expenses which are tied to a CIP amendment.

Six amendments to the 2019-2023 Capital Improvement Program that require an appropriation of new funds are included in this ordinance:

BRB002, Broadband Aid to Construction ELE044, Electric System Reliability Improvements PRO205, Tull & Distel Property Acquisition TRP011, Transportation System Management Program TRP012, Vance Brand Airport Improvements TRP127, 1st Ave and Emery St Intersection Improvements
