Summer Reading Club

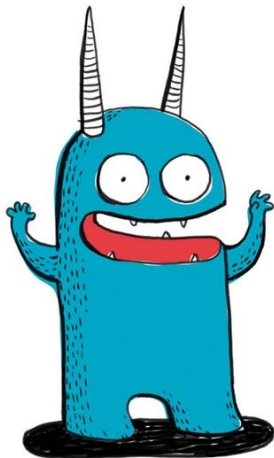
*TD Summer Reading Club registration begins **June 27th**.*
