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Methodology

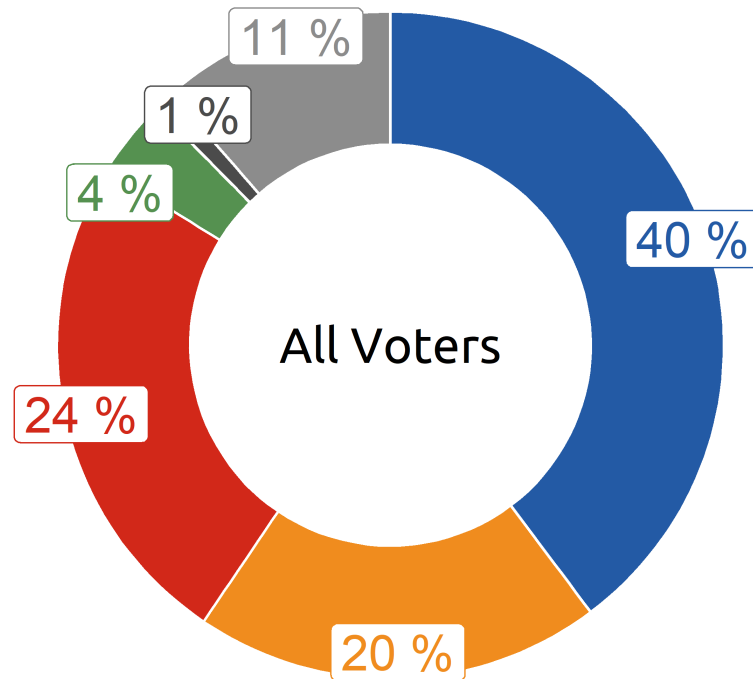
The analysis in this report is based on results of a survey conducted from February 1st-2nd, 2025 among a sample of 1014 adults, 18 years of age or older, living in Ontario and are eligible to vote in provincial elections. The survey was conducted using automated telephone interviews using Interactive Voice Recording technology (IVR). Respondents were interviewed on landlines and cellular phones. The sample was weighted by age, gender, and region according to the 2021 Census. The survey is intended to represent the adult population in Ontario.

The margin of error for the poll is $\pm 3.1\%$, at the 95% confidence level. Margins of error are higher in each subsample.

Totals may not add up 100% due to rounding.

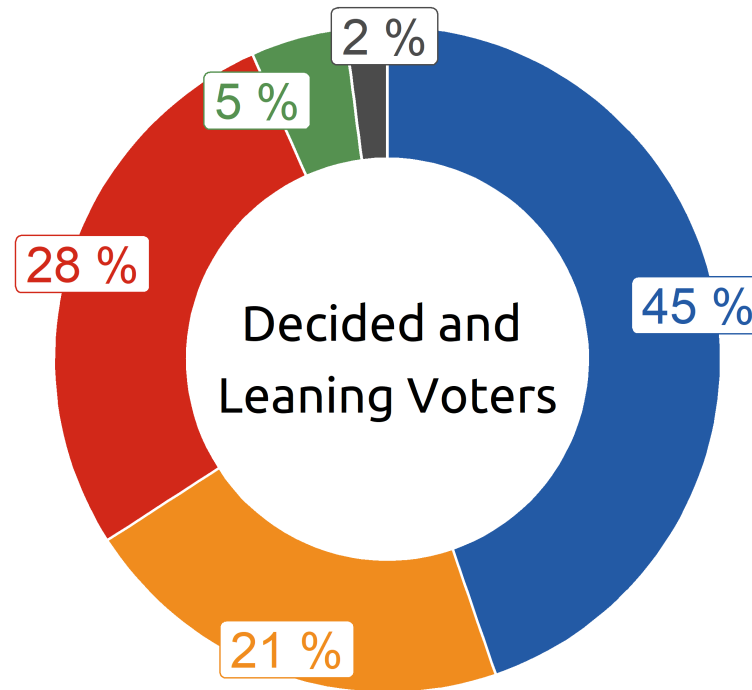
If a provincial election were held today, which party would you vote for?

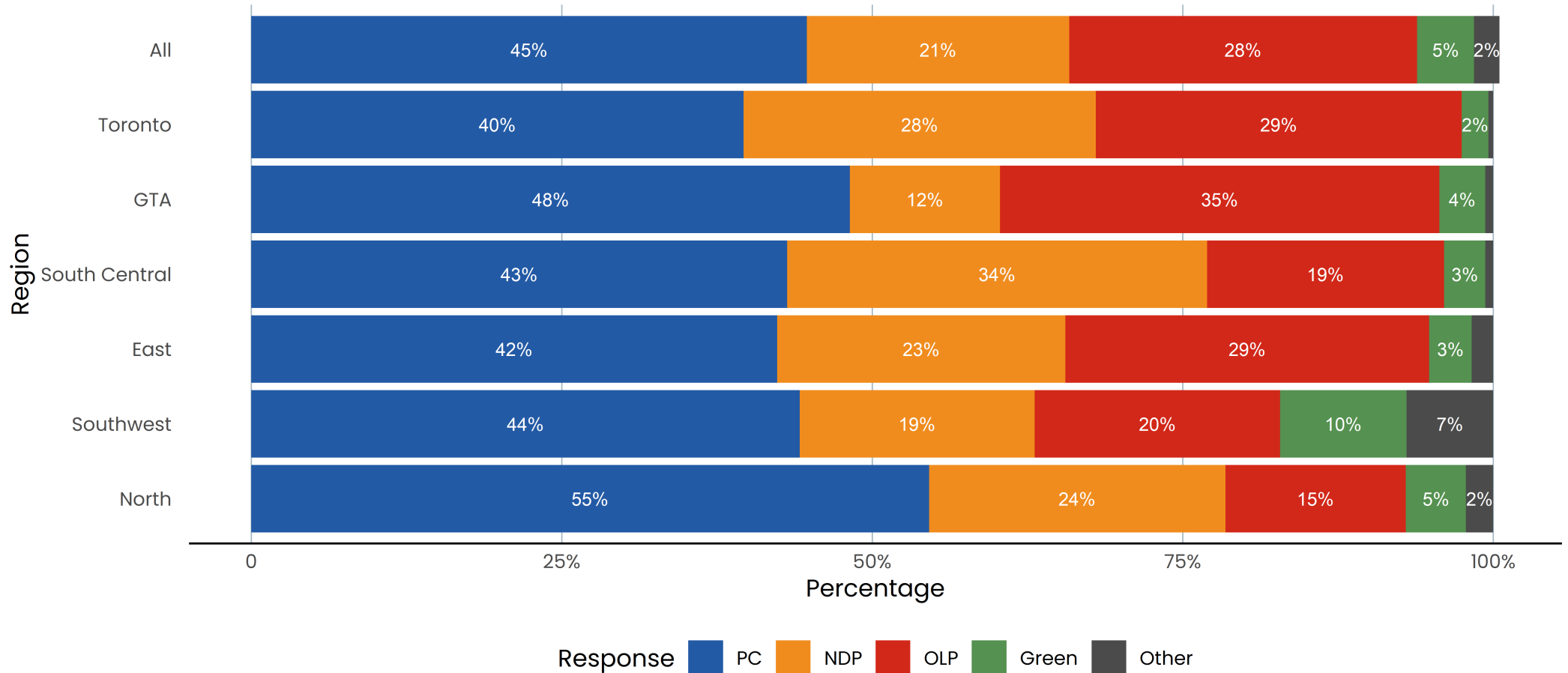

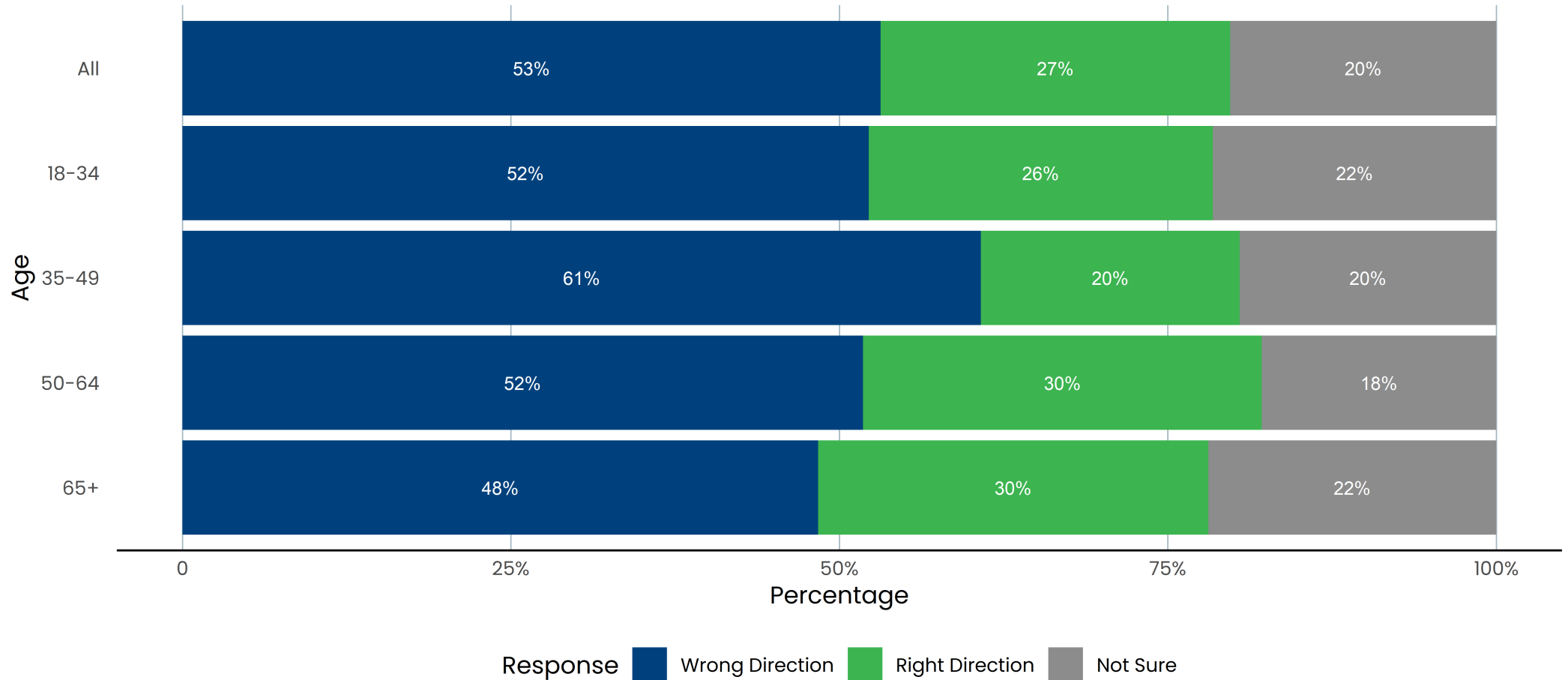

Ontario: Going In The Wrong Direction

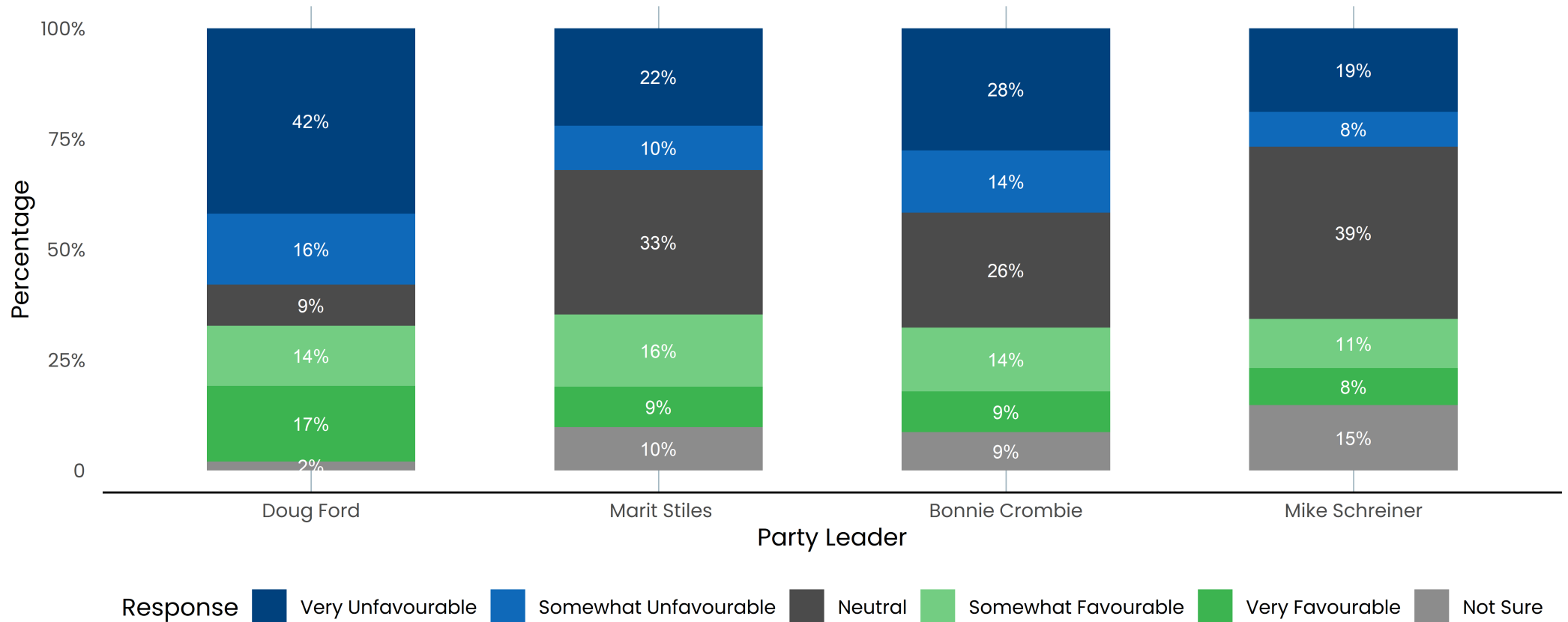
Do you think Ontario is headed in the right or wrong direction?

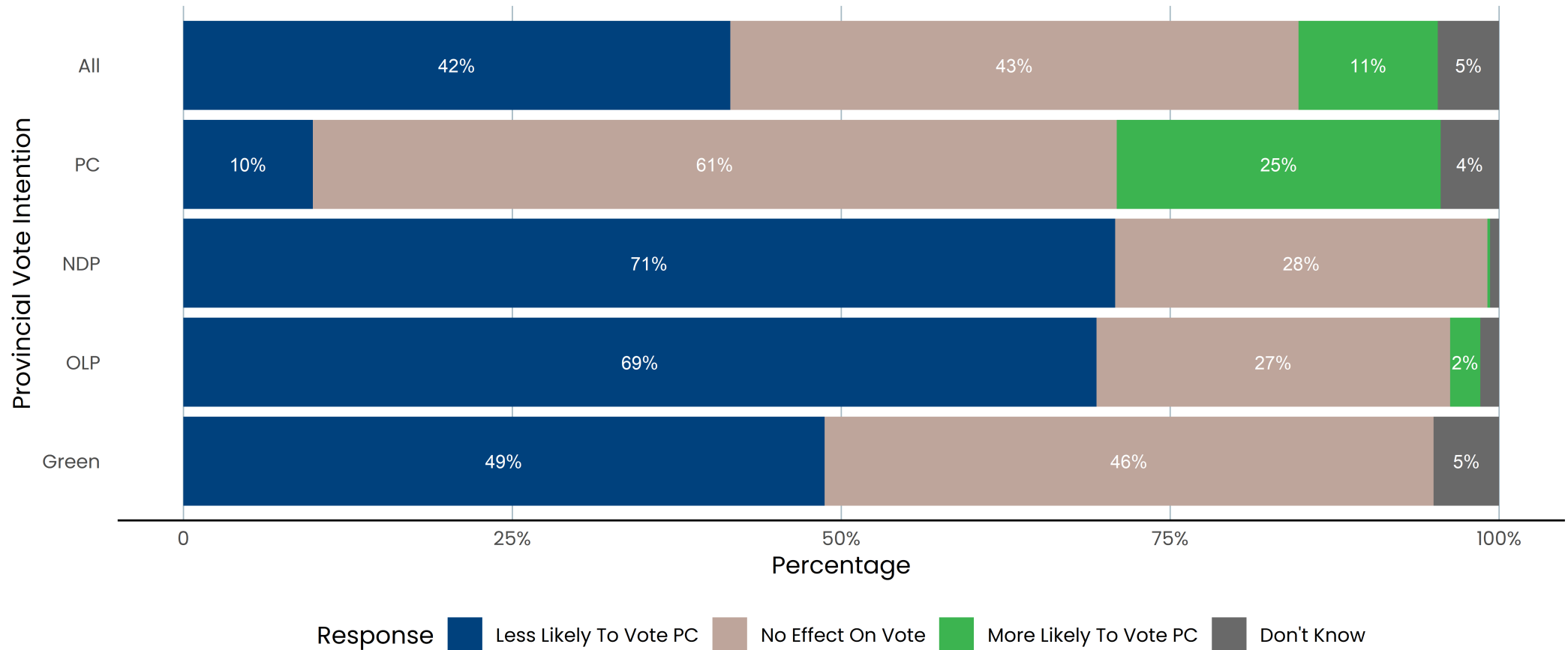

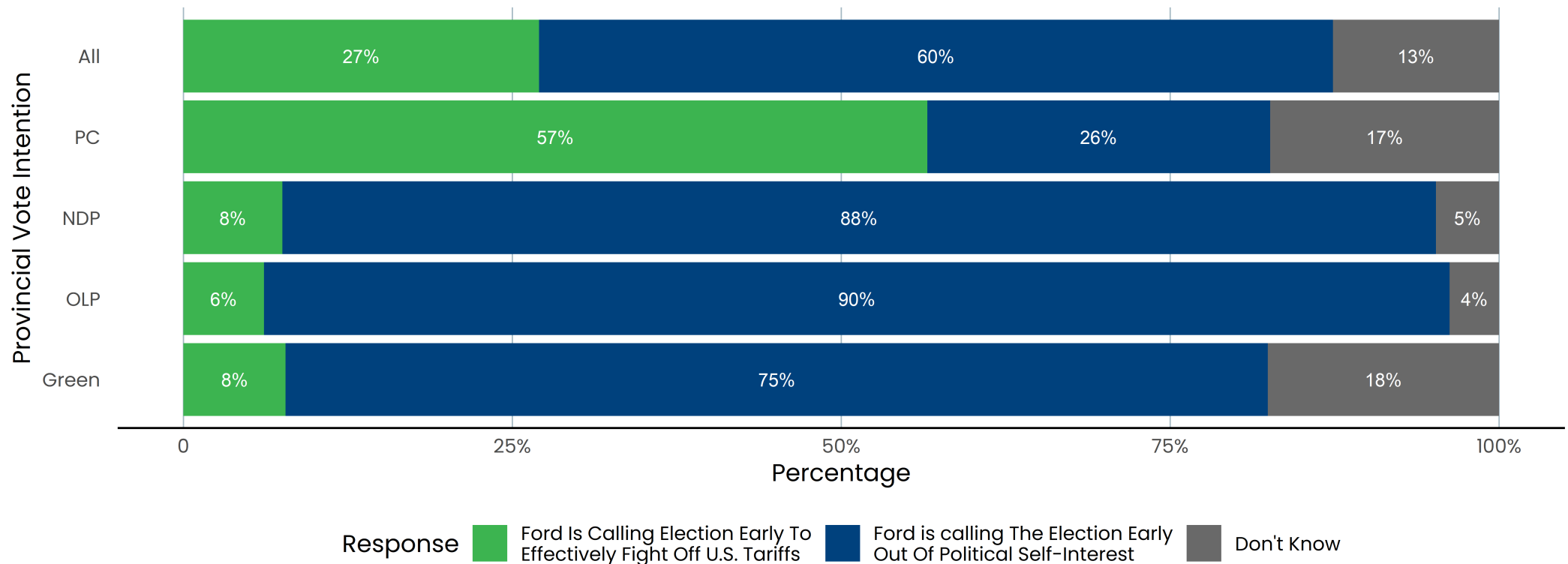

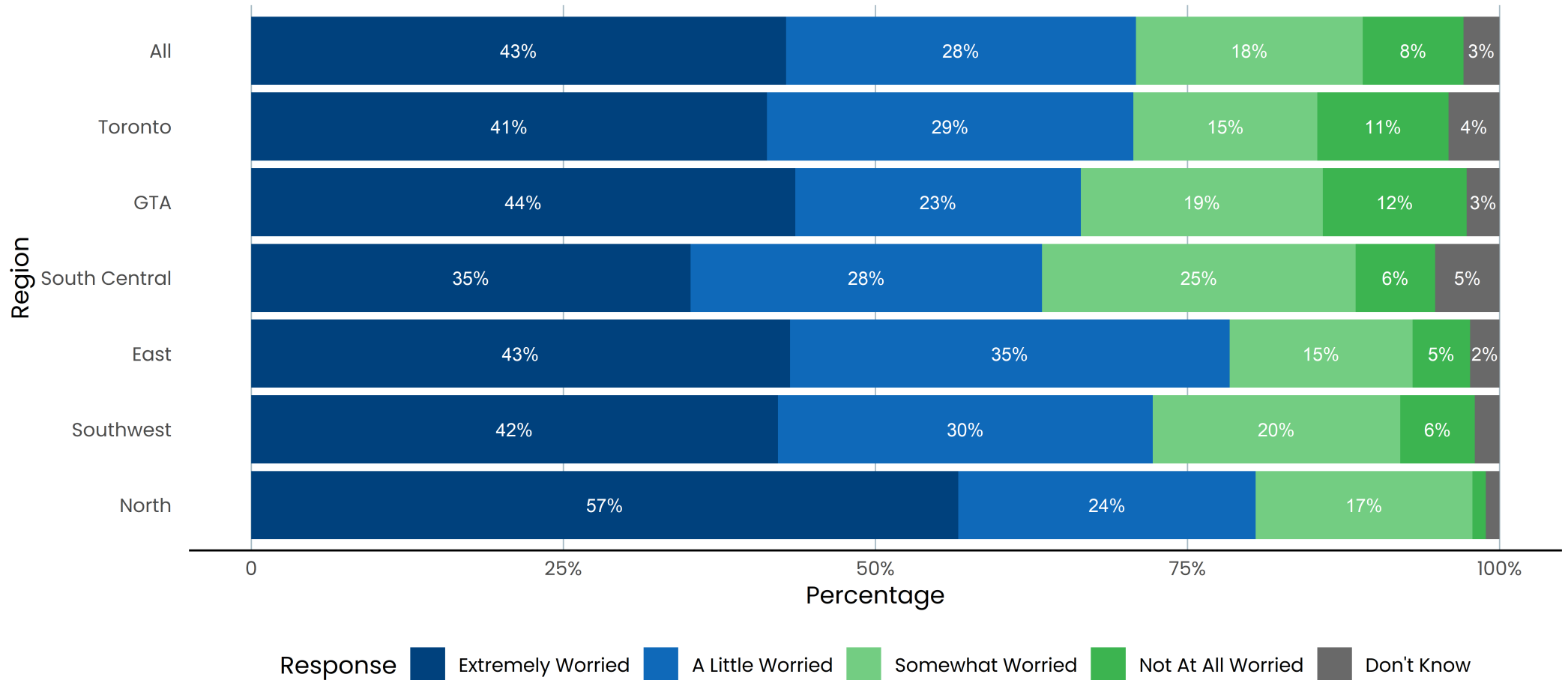

Massive Concern About U.S. Tariffs

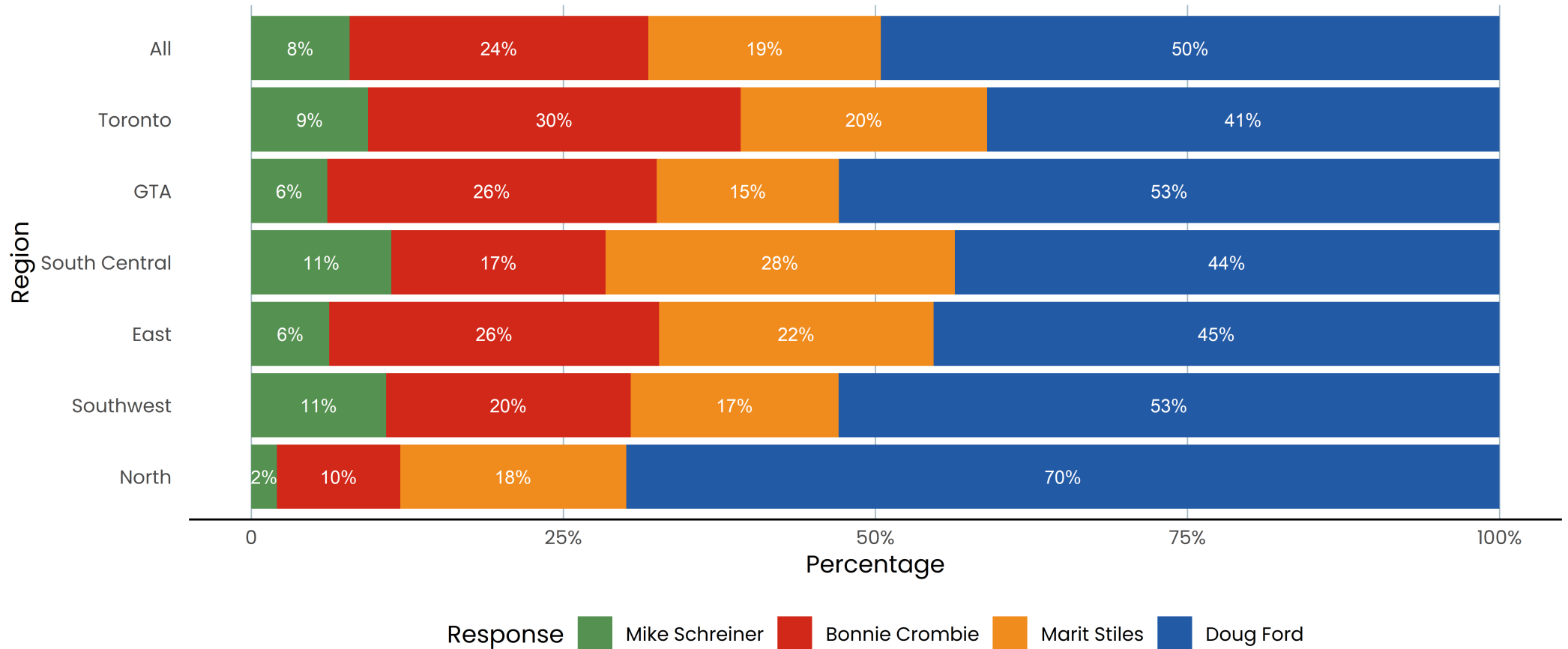
How worried are you about the potential U.S. tariffs?
