Methodology

The analysis in this report is based on results of a survey conducted from August 28-29th, 2023 among a sample of 940 adults, 18 years of age or older, living in Ontario and are eligible to vote in provincial elections. The survey was conducted using automated telephone interviews using Interactive Voice Recording technology (IVR). Respondents were interviewed on landlines and cellular phones. The sample was weighted by age, gender, and region according to the 2021 Census. The survey is intended to represent the adult population in Ontario.

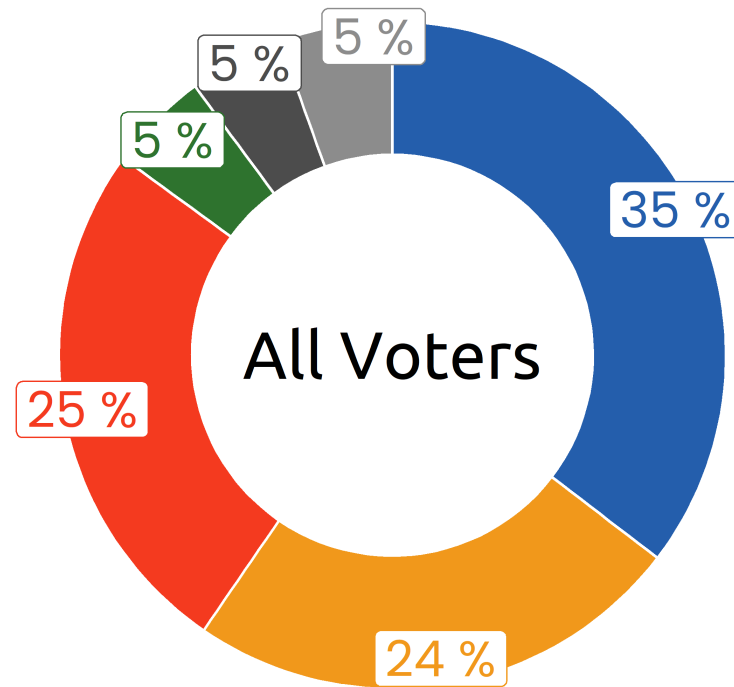
This survey was sponsored by Village Media.

The margin of error for the poll is $\pm 3.2\%$ at the 95% confidence level. Margins of error are higher in each subsample.

Provincial Voting Intention

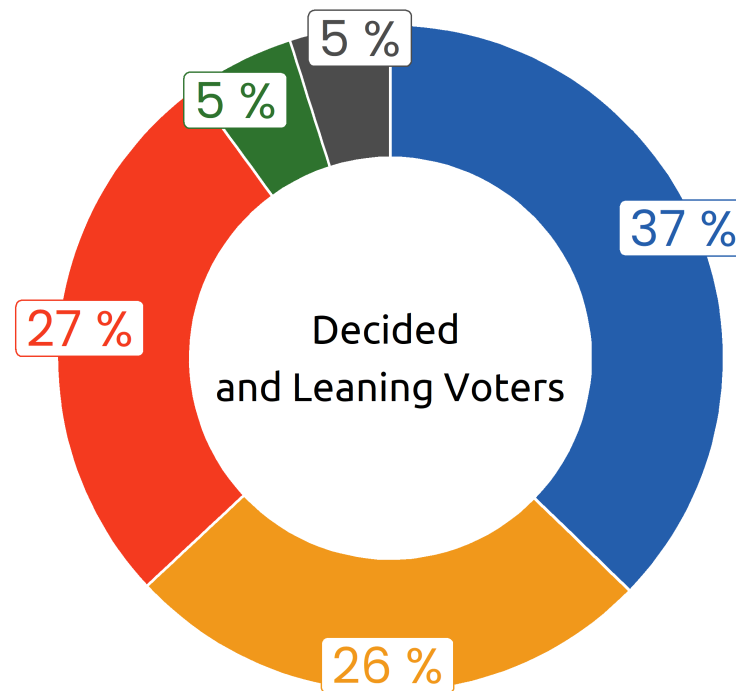
If a provincial election were held today, which party would you vote for?

If a provincial election were held today, which party would you vote for?

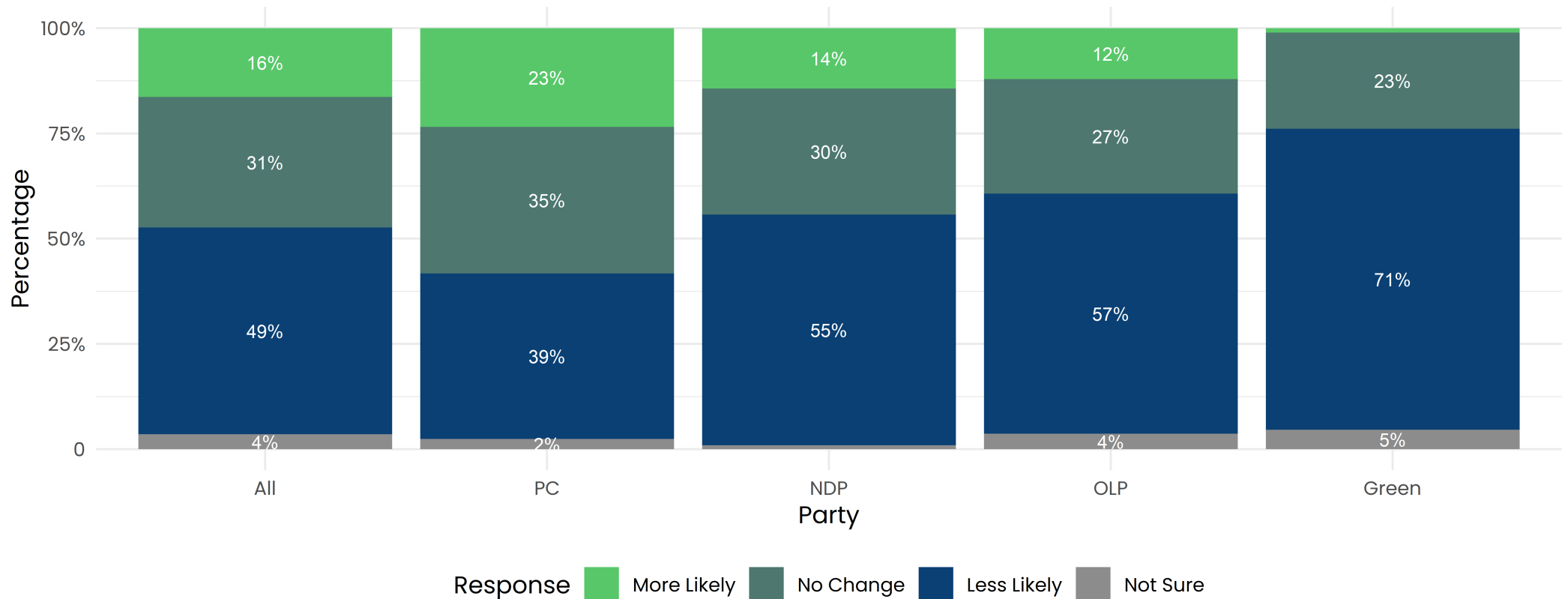

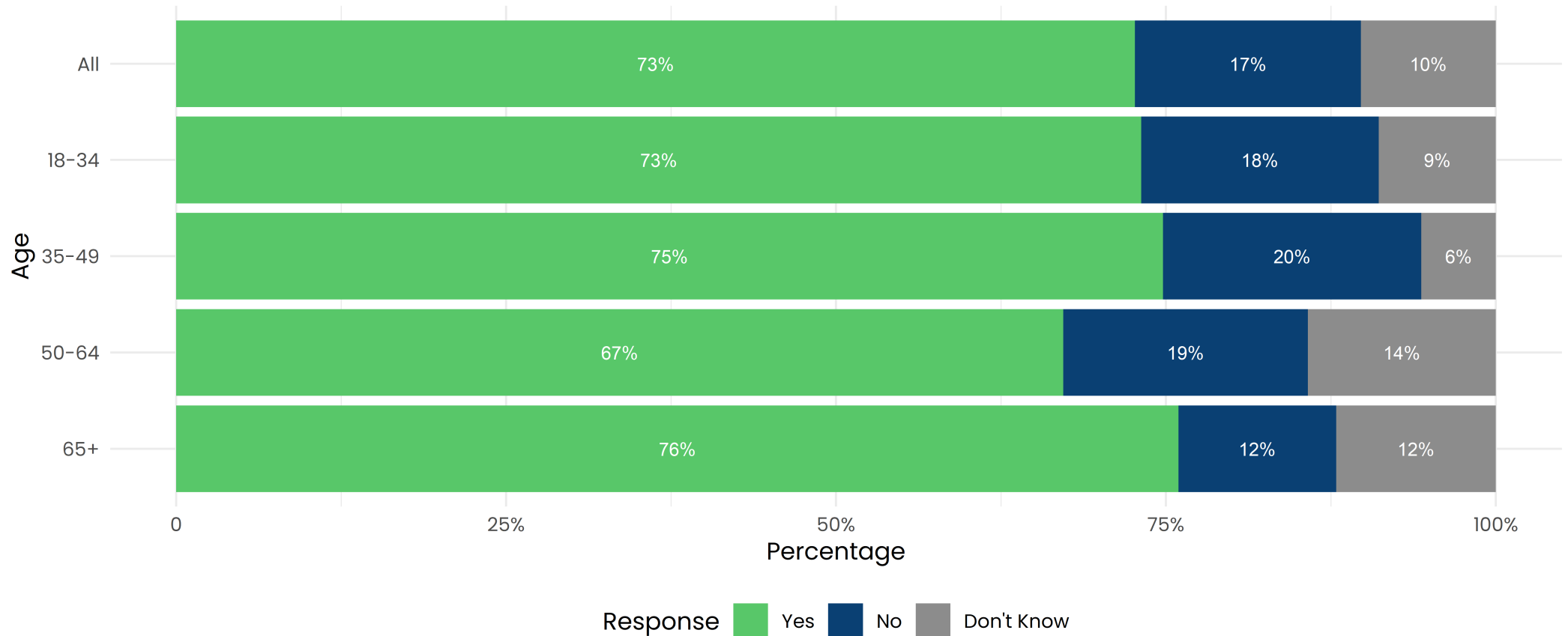

Potential RCMP Investigation

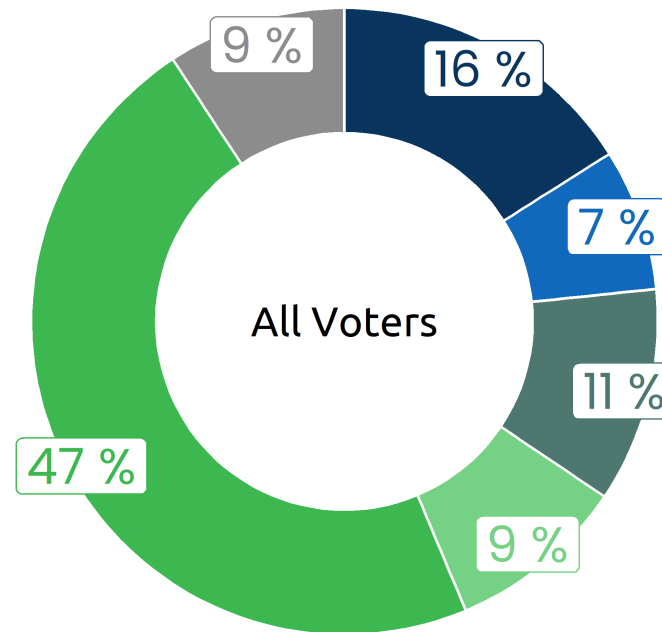

To what extent do you agree with the following: The Ontario government's process of selecting lands from the Greenbelt for development was corrupt.

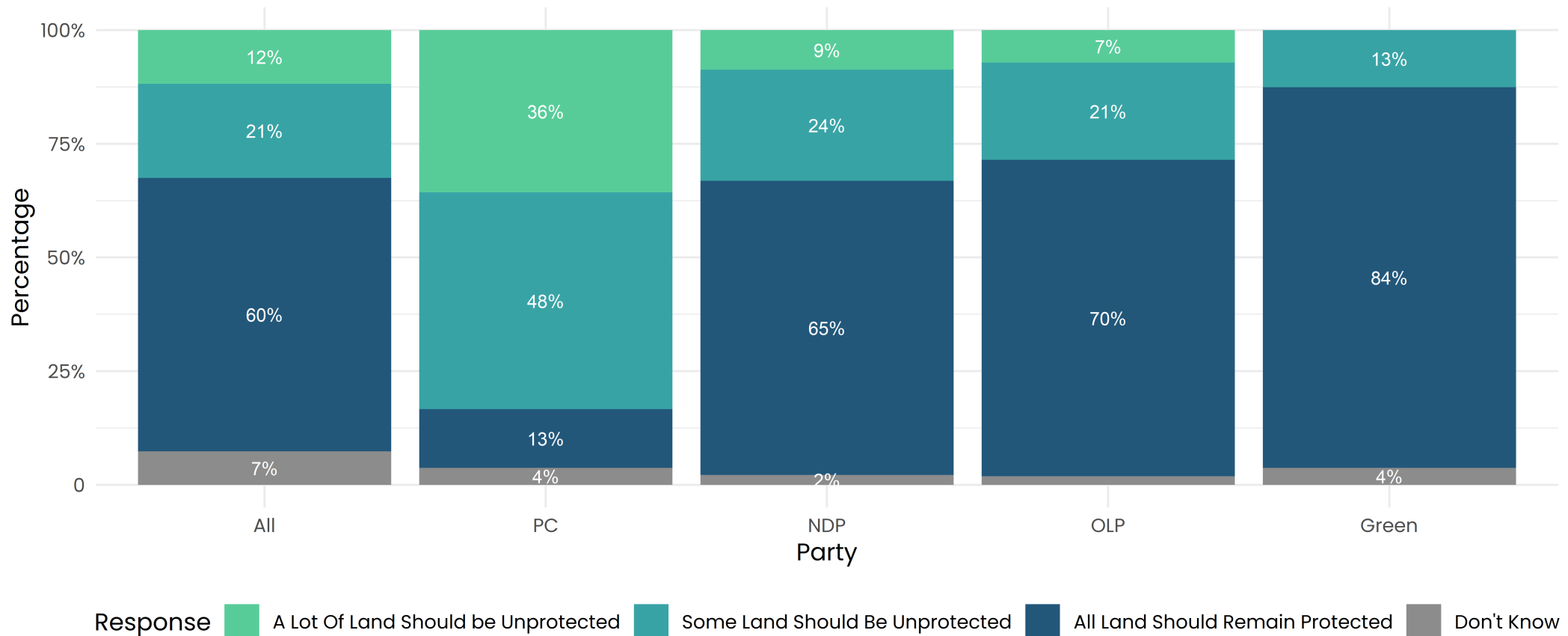
